

IEEE Technical Committee on Learning Technology (TCLT)

Call for applications for

2016 Young Researcher Award

IEEE TCLT invites applications for *Young Researcher Award in Advanced Learning Technologies*. Up to two awards will be made on the innovative nature of the research.

- The applicant should have received PhD after 30 June 2011.
- Only research innovations created after 30 June 2011 would be counted in the assessment process.

The criteria for judging the applications will include impact of the innovation(s), the cutting-edge nature, and the benefits of the applicant's research work to the advancement of advanced learning technologies.

The awards will be announced during the 2016 IEEE International Conference on Advanced Learning Technologies (ICALT 2016). Awardees present at the conference will receive a prize and a certificate during the award ceremony at the conference. If any awardee is not able to attend the ICALT 2016 conference, his/her prize and certificate will be sent by mail.

Application format:

Applications must include the following (please use the numbering and headings as listed below):

1. Applicant's name, designation and affiliation.
2. Applicant's short CV (maximum two pages), including a copy of the certificate with the date of PhD award
3. Description of innovations (maximum two pages) - Each innovation should be listed as follows:
 - a) Title of innovation
 - b) Brief description of the innovation
 - c) Brief explanation of how this innovation has been useful for community (evidence of impact)
 - d) Brief explanation of how it is unique compared to other similar efforts available in the literature (evidence of cutting-edge nature)
 - e) Brief explanation of how it advances the field of advanced learning technologies
 - f) Website address of demo (or more details) of the innovation, if available.

Note: If the innovation is created jointly with other researchers, a clear explanation of each person's contribution and a letter from the others confirming their agreement with the explanation of contribution and indicating who was leading the innovation.

4. Two references from outside of applicant's organization. These referees should be at arms' length (they should not have collaborated with the applicant in past five years). The references should be sent directly to TCLT award committee chairs by email.

Submission procedure:
